ST MARY'S TB APCM

The PCC of St Mary's TB will be meeting online this week and will confirm the planned date of the postponed annual parochial church meeting which will be held in early September. As there will be a monthly rather than weekly notice sheet for August, the date will be published on the Benefice website and church noticeboards, but it is likely to be immediately after a shortened 10.30am service in early September.

MISSION- HOW CAN WE HELP?

Although we have had to suspend all our fund-raising activities, we all can still play a part in praying for the health, protection and resilience of all those involved in working for the charities and for the communities they serve. This year has been particularly hard for them, financially and practically, but prayer is at the heart of all their work, and whatever their situation, they are strengthened and inspired by knowing that they are not alone and that so many people care about them and their work, and we know that God answers prayer. The Mission to Seafarers, one of the organisations we support, operates in over 250 ports worldwide, providing support and care to seafarers of all nationalities, many stranded and desperate at this time of pandemic. "Dear Lord, we pray for the work of Seafarers' Missions, their chaplains and ships visitors around the world; for seafarers facing dangers and hardships, and loneliness far from home. We pray for their families. Bless and protect them all. Amen."
