FUNERALS IN CHURCH

End of life ministry continues to be offered, and it is now possible for funeral services to take place in the church buildings as well as burials in the churchyards.

SUNDAY EVENING ZOOM SERVICE

There will be a Benefice Sunday evening service each week at 6.00pm on Zoom, alternating between Sung Compline and Sung Evensong. COUNSELLING SUPPORT

The Association of Christian Counsellors is offering up to 10 sessions of counselling on a no-fee basis by telephone or online. These are available to those who have been working within the NHS who are directly impacted by COVID-19 including frontline medical staff, paramedics and those in ancillary roles in an NHS setting (e.g. nursing assistants, cleaners, porters, etc.) and anyone who has been bereaved during this time, whether related to the virus or not.
