#### THEYDON GARNON BANK ACCOUNT DETAILS

Some people have had a problem making an online bank transfer into the Theydon Garnon account. The sort code (202986) and account number (10871788) as previously printed are correct. The problem is that some systems reject the account name when entered as 'Theydon Garnon PCC' (although this is acceptable on cheques). The solution is to enter the full name 'Theydon Garnon Parochial Church Council'. If making an online payment, please enter your name in the Reference field so the payment can be identified. Thank you.

#### SUNDAY EVENING ZOOM SERVICE

The choir of St Mary's TB held a successful trial service of Compline on Zoom last Sunday with a "congregation" of 24. Going forward, there will be Benefice Sunday evening service each week at 6.00pm on Zoom, alternating between Sung Compline and Sung Evensong.
