SOCIAL VALUE OF THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND

An exceptionally interesting report has been issued by the National Churches Trust. (Sometimes as Christians we get a little depressed, but this theme is uplifting.) The Trust estimates that the Church's financial contribution to society is £12.4 billion a year! Before the pandemic, the Church of England said that its Churches were running or supporting 35,000 projects including 8,000 food banks, 40,000 parent-toddler groups, 5,000 lunch clubs or coffee mornings, 2,700 community cafés, 2,400 night shelters, and 2,300 breakfast or holiday clubs for children. These are the basic

services and they exclude the individual contributions of Christians in society; and we must bear in mind that the Church's contribution cannot ever truly be costed because it involves spiritual and salvific value. It is indirectly inspiring of many good works, and amongst its hidden values are health, well-being, prayer and the miraculous. The truth is that faith is priceless.
