Parochial Church Council Meetings

The PCC met 6 times during the year, plus the APCM. Some meetings were via Zoom, others were in person.

The parish continues to work towards the shared Benefice Vision of the Theydon Parishes which is:-

To be loving, caring and welcoming congregations who nurture each other to grow in faith together, through quality worship, Bible teaching and prayer, sharing the love of God in Christ with others by example and our activities in the community and wider world.

Sub-committees

Events Committee: Organises social and fund-raising events to support the Church, chaired by Maggie Dennis. Parish Lunches and Open Days continue to be held. **Pastoral Care**: Co-ordinates pastoral care needs and liaises with clergy, with Gill Southall acting as a hub.

Churchyard: Although not a formal committee, an informal group of neighbours meet to help maintain the churchyard on an occasional basis at St Mary's.

Most services were Holy Communion, with some Services of the Word.

Special services were held on Good Friday, Easter Day, Harvest, Carol Service,

Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, and a Christingle service at Candlemas in February. A lunchtime Lent course was held in the Parish Room at St Mary's. On the first Sunday of July, a Pets' Service was held in the churchyard at St Mary's.

Visiting organists played on a rota arrangement. When no organist was available, electronic music was provided.

On an average Sunday, 12-20 adults attended worship. There was one wedding and one adult baptism at St Mary's. There were three funeral services during the year at St Mary's (Maurice Padfield, Tony Squire and Jacquie Larkin) and two at St Michael's (Tina Bellamy and Jack Stewart).
